CMCS Homeschool Connect Program

Family & Student Code of Conduct

The CMCS Homeschool Connect Program exists to provide homeschool families with opportunities for academic enrichment, fellowship, service, and community within a distinctly Christian environment. Although participants are not enrolled as full-time students at Clinch Mountain Christian School (CMCS), they are welcomed as members of the CMCS community while participating in the program. As such, all families are expected to uphold the mission, values, and standards of CMCS.

Participation in the Homeschool Connect Program is contingent upon the following expectations:

Commitment to CMCS Beliefs and Policies

Parents/guardians must acknowledge that they have read, understand, and agree to support the following CMCS governing documents:

- CMCS Statement of Faith
- CMCS Statement on Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality
- CMCS Statement on the Sanctity of Human Life

Additionally, all participating families agree to abide by all applicable policies, procedures, and expectations outlined in the CMCS Student & Family Handbook.

Student Conduct

Students participating in the Homeschool Connect Program are expected to strive to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects Christian character at all times while participating in any CMCS-sponsored activity, including classes, extracurricular activities, field trips, athletic events, service projects, and other school functions.



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Students are expected to strive to:

- demonstrate Christ-like behavior through kindness, respect, honesty, self-control, and encouragement toward others.
- Show respect for faculty, staff, volunteers, fellow students, parents, and school property.
- Follow all instructions given by CMCS faculty, staff, and designated volunteers.
- Refrain from behavior that is disruptive, disrespectful, inappropriate, or unsafe.
- Represent Christ, themselves, their families, and the CMCS community with integrity both on and off campus during CMCS activities.

Dress Code

Homeschool Connect students are required to follow the CMCS Dress Code as outlined in the Student & Family Handbook while attending any CMCS classes, activities, field trips, or events. Families are responsible for ensuring students arrive dressed appropriately according to school policy.

Discipline

Students participating in the Homeschool Connect Program are subject to the same behavioral expectations and disciplinary standards as enrolled CMCS students.

Failure to comply with school policies, demonstrate appropriate conduct, or follow the directions of CMCS faculty and staff may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or immediate dismissal from the Homeschool Connect Program at the discretion of the Head of School.

Parent Responsibilities

Parents play a vital role in the success of the Homeschool Connect Program and agree to:

- Support and reinforce CMCS policies and expectations with their children.



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- Ensure their child arrives prepared, appropriately dressed, and on time for all activities.
- Attend and actively supervise their own children during all CMCS field trips unless otherwise communicated by CMCS administration.
- Communicate respectfully and constructively with CMCS faculty, staff, volunteers, and other families.
- Partner with CMCS in maintaining a Christ-centered environment for all participants.

Representation of the CMCS Community

Although Homeschool Connect participants are not enrolled as full-time CMCS students, they are valued members of the CMCS community while participating in the program. Families and students are expected to remember that their words, attitudes, and actions reflect not only on themselves, but also on Christ and the ministry of Clinch Mountain Christian School.

Every interaction should demonstrate the love, humility, and integrity that Scripture calls believers to exhibit.

Dismissal from the Program

Participation in the CMCS Homeschool Connect Program is a privilege.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct, the CMCS Student & Family Handbook, or any of the required governing statements may result in dismissal from the Homeschool Connect Program at the sole discretion of the Head of School.

If a student or family is dismissed from the program due to violation of this Code of Conduct or any CMCS policy, all program fees and tuition previously paid are non-refundable.
